- Offering low- and no-cost vaccination clinics to the public and other rescue organizations

- Facilitating publications, special events, community activities, and legislation that supports the activities of the shelter
- Developing a rescue/transfer program
- Holding basic, obedience, behavioral, health, and other training classes
- Continually improving our capabilities and capacity to handle those animals in need

We will work with local governments, municipalities, other rescue organizations, and caring citizens, to efficiently and effectively bring about the changes necessary to accomplish our mission.
